Official launch of MARINE website

www.anmb.ro/marine went live on April 5th 2013 with the goal of disseminating relevant information to wider public regarding Maritime network of education for the development of the maritime culture in the Black Sea basin project.

First Partner and Steering Committee Meeting

The First Partner Meeting of the MARINE project was held on May 9th 2013 at Piri Reis University (PRU), Turkey with participation of the staff members from all partners organizations.



Prof.Dr. Osman Kamil Sag, rector of the PRU welcomed the participants and emphasized the importance of this cooperation.

The agenda included presentations of the general objectives and expected results, the

role and resources of each partner in the implementation of the project and development of the project website and Portal.



Development of Maritime Education and Training in View of Maritime History and the Cultural Heritage of the Black Sea Basin Conference

Piri Reis University (PRU) hosted on May 10th 2013 the Opening Conference of the MARINE project. Deputy Minister for EU Affairs Dr. Alaattin Büyükkaya, Admiral Metin Ataç, former Commander of the Turkish Naval Forces, representatives of the Chamber of Shipping and media attended to this event.

In his speech, Deputy Minister Dr. BÜYÜKKAYA pointed out that the Programme helps strengthening the cooperation between non-governmental organizations and local





authorities, ENPI Cross Border Cooperation at the Black Sea Basin Programme is of great importance despite its limited budget. Furthermore, Deputy Minister stated that the Programme will continue to be implemented during 2014- 2020 budget period with higher grant support from both the EU and the Ministry.

PRU communication and PR expert Dr. Taner Albayrak presented the project highlighting the aims, objectives and expected outcomes.

The representatives of the partner institutions presented papers in line with the general theme of the conference.

In the conference folder a feedback and evaluation questionnaire was included and about half of the 285 participants have completed the form.



All the attenders appreciated the conference as being relevant to its objectives. 96 percent were interested in the issues discussed at the conference and would like to receive further information.

Developing the MARPLAT platform

In July 2013 the web administrator from Mircea cel Batran Naval Academy has developed the functional specification which defines and describes the operations, interfaces and quality assurance requirements of the MARPLAT platform.

There are 23 requirements structured on sections such as: Professional training, Forum, Target audience structure, Assessment of vocational guidance, Blog and Online Courses.

The specifications have been discussed with the partners and the public procurement procedures will follow.
